



## 2006 Midwest Championship Hillclimb Invitational

September 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2006 – Troy, KS

Over the Hill Racing, Inc. is pleased to invite you to compete in the 2006 Midwest Championship Hillclimb Invitational! The top 12 riders in each class from AMA Districts 15, 16, 17, and 23, as well as top riders from Kansas and Missouri as of July 30<sup>th</sup>, 2006 automatically qualify for their respective classes, as do the top 5 riders from each 2005 King of the Hill Championship Series (top 5 from IL/IN, MN/WI, and KS/MO) for the King of the Hill Grudge Match. Additional riders may be extended invitations at the discretion of Over the Hill Racing.

Over the Hill Racing, Inc. will run the following classes at the Championship:

50cc auto (4-8 years old)	65cc (6-11 years old)	Jr. Mini (85cc 7-11 years old)
Sr. Mini (85cc 12-15 yrs. old)	86cc – 125cc	126cc – 200cc
201cc – 250cc	251cc – 450cc	451cc – 600cc
601cc – 750cc	Open	86cc – 600cc 4-Stroke
Senior (40+ years old)	Super Senior (50+ years old)	2-Stroke ATV (any cc)
4-Stroke ATV (any cc)	King of the Hill*	King of the Hill Grudge Match*

\* The **King of the Hill** class will be run each day (scored as a 2-event series with one award) with the 10 fastest riders of the day. The **King of the Hill Grudge Match** will run Saturday, with the top 5 riders' from last year's KOTH series (IL/IN, MN/WI, and KS/MO). These classes will not require an additional entry fee.

Each rider may ride up to 3 classes (as qualified or per special invitation, not including KOTH classes). The Championship is a 2-event series, consisting of one event Saturday and one event Sunday. Only one entry fee is required per class, which covers both days of competition. Riders will receive free admission at the gate. Gate fees for non-riders are \$7.00 each day, or \$12.00 for the weekend. Children 12 and under get in free.

Awards will be given on Sunday based on the series results using the following points schedule:

1 <sup>st</sup> place = 100 points	6 <sup>th</sup> place = 84 points
2 <sup>nd</sup> place = 96 points	7 <sup>th</sup> place = 82 points
3 <sup>rd</sup> place = 92 points	8 <sup>th</sup> place = 81 points
4 <sup>th</sup> place = 89 points	9 <sup>th</sup> place = 80 points
5 <sup>th</sup> place = 86 points	10 <sup>th</sup> place = 79 points

...continuing down by 1 point per place. Any ties in points at the end of Sunday's event will be broken by averaging all 4 rides for each affected rider. Ties during either Saturday or Sunday will be broken based on the riders' other (2<sup>nd</sup> best) ride. The King of the Hill class will be scored based on the same placement schedule used for the KOTH Championship Series events – in the event of a tie for first place, those two riders will have a one-run run-off (ties for other places will not be broken). Awards will be presented to the Top ten in each regular class based on their final series standing at the end of Sunday's event. There will be a KOTH Midwest Championship award and a cash prize provided to the series Winner of the King of the Hill class, provided by [www.KingOfTheHill.org](http://www.KingOfTheHill.org) and Over the Hill Racing.

The King of the Hill class will be run each day after all regular classes have concluded. The King of the Hill Grudge Match will be run on Saturday after all other classes have concluded.

*Details of the King of the Hill Grudge Match:*

- Top 5 riders from each 2005 KOTH Championship Series (IL/IN, MN/WI, or KS/MO) qualify
- No additional entry fee
- Premium Grudge Match award plus a cash prize provided by [www.KingOfTheHill.org](http://www.KingOfTheHill.org) and Over the Hill Racing, Inc.
- All riders must ride 451cc-600cc class machines
  - This is to even the playing field, to emphasize the rider, and not the machine
- Riders are permitted to borrow a 451cc-600cc machine if they do not own one (from a non-grudge match rider – the same bike cannot be ridden by 2 riders)
- This is a one-run event

Entry forms must be postmarked by August 12<sup>th</sup>, 2006 to ensure proper registration. Over the Hill Racing may extend special invitations to riders who otherwise would not qualify to ensure full classes and representation of top riders. Riding order will be the inverse of the order that entries were received – the first rider to register rides last, and the last rider to register rides first (the rider leading a class after the first round may choose to run last in the second round, if they would prefer – all other riders ride in order).

Please be aware that **NO** entries will be accepted on race day! We will have all of our scoring forms, riding orders, etc. ready to go before the first day of racing on Saturday, so please do not just show up on Saturday (or Sunday) and expect to sign up and race!

The Over the Hill Racing facility is located 3.5 miles west of Troy, KS or 9 miles east of St. Joseph, MO right on US 36 Highway. Can't miss it.

Camping will be allowed at Over the Hill Racing grounds. All riders and their families are welcome to stay.

St. Joseph, MO (15 minutes from the hill) has a population of over 100,000 people. All national food and motel chains are well represented.
